## RIDER RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

### B. Activity Risk Classification

RIDER UNDERSTANDS THAT: Horseback riding is a hazardous activity containing numerous inherent, obvious and non-obvious risks that always present themselves in such activity, despite all safety precautions. Related injuries can be severe, resulting in more lasting residual effects than injuries from other activities. Horses are unpredictable and participation in activities in the presence of horses always involves an element of risk. Pursuant to Act 93 of 2005, the Pennsylvania Activity Immunity Act, "You assume the risk of equine activities pursuant to Pennsylvania Law."

### C. Nature of Riding Horses

RIDER UNDERSTANDS THAT: No horse is a completely safe horse. Regardless of a horse's training or past experience, a horse may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, bolt, stumble, rear, kick, run, stop short, fall, bite, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's foot/feet, push or shove a person, saddles, girths or bridles may loosen or break, all of which may cause Rider to fall or be jolted, resulting in property damage, personal injury, or death. DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC is not responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse or cause it to fall or react in any unsafe way.

### D. Rider Responsibility

RIDER UNDERSTANDS THAT: Rider is in primary control of the horse and DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC is not responsible for Rider's actions or inactions. Rider is responsible for their own safety and that of an unborn child if Rider is pregnant. Pregnant persons should ride horses only under the advice of their physician.

### E. Protective Equipment/Headgear Requirement

As a condition of riding any horse in the Adult Amateur Dressage Show, Rider is required by DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC to wear and utilize all protective clothing and equipment, including long pants, gloves, protective headgear and proper riding shoes with heels, at all times while mounting, riding, and dismounting horses. Rider's headgear must meet or exceed ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carry the SEI tag. The headgear and its harness must be secured, properly fitted and fastened at all times while mounting, riding, and dismounting horses. If Rider is in violation of this requirement at any time, Rider must immediately discontinue riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Closed toe shoes that cover the whole foot are required by all persons on the horse facilities, at all times when working with or around horses. Rider is responsible for ensuring all their spectators and guests abide by this rule if they come within 6 feet of a horse.

**F. Property**

RIDER AGREES THAT: DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC is not responsible for lost or stolen personal property of any kind, including saddles, and any other item of value. Rider acknowledges it is their responsibility to secure and insure their personal property.

**G. Dunmovin’s Use of My Name and Image**

I understand that DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC may take photos or videos of Rider. Rider consents to the use by DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC of Rider’s image, voice, name, and stories (collectively, “Materials”), in DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC’s digital and print promotional, fundraising, educational, and other communications. DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC may use the Materials without obtaining Rider’s approval or paying Rider for such use. I grant DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC all copyrights in and waive any legal claims relating to the Materials, including those relating to copyright, rights of publicity or privacy, or defamation, or arising from any distortion, blurring, or alteration that may occur in the making, editing, or use of the Materials.

**H. Indemnification and Liability Release – PLEASE READ VERY CAREFULLY**

RIDER AGREES THAT: In consideration of DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC allowing Rider’s participation in the Adult Amateur Dressage Show and allowing Rider’s guests and/or spectators on the show grounds, I agree for myself and on behalf of my, heirs, administrators, personal representatives or assigns, shall forever save, hold harmless, defend, and indemnify DUNMOVIN ENTERPRISES LLC (doing business under its own name or any other name), its owners, affiliates, members, insurers, employees, assigns, and others acting on its behalf (each a “Released Party”), from any and all claims, liabilities, demands, suits, damages, costs, expenses and causes of action (each, a “Claim”), including the negligence of a Released Party, whether the same be known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, anticipated or unanticipated, economic or non-economic, arising out of Rider’s or their guests and spectators use of, or presence upon the show grounds property where Rider participates in the equine activities, the facilities or horses. Rider shall not bring any claims against any Released Party resulting from or arising out of any loss, damage, injury, loss of life or property damage, sustained by Rider or any of Rider’s guests or spectators arising out of, or presence upon, the property where the equine activities are held, the facilities or horses.

**I. Governing Law**

RIDER AGREES THAT: This Release and Waiver of Liability is non-assignable and non-transferable, and shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Chester County, without regard to conflicts of laws principles. In the event that any provision of this Release and Waiver of Liability shall be unenforceable or invalid under any applicable law or be so held by applicable court state decision, such unenforceability or invalidity shall not render this whole Release and Waiver of Liability unenforceable or invalid as a whole.
