## PERFORMANCE DIRECTIVES

- Amateur and Junior/Young Rider Status
- Competitors must not have trained any horse/rider combination for compensation.
- Amateur Status: Please refer to USEF Rules GR101, GR1306, and DR119.3.
- Junior/Young Rider Status: Please refer to USEF Rule DR119.3.
- Lead Line: 8 YO and under.
- Classes will be split and pinned separately based on Amateur and Junior/Young Rider status within the guidelines of USEF Rules GR1306 and DR119.3.

## ENTRIES

- All entrants in this competition enter with the agreement that they have read and understand this Official Prize List and agree to follow all class specifications, requirements, directives, regulations, policies, terms, and conditions contained herein.
- Online entries only. Enter online using the [Amateur Only Show Entry Form](#).
- All entries must be complete with full payment and required documents as described below. Management reserves the right to return entries that are incomplete or inaccurate.
- No exhibitor is permitted to compete until all fees are paid in full.
- Competitors are subject to USEF Non-Negotiable Funds Rule GR1508.1.

## Required Documents

- Negative Coggins dated within one year of the competition date.
- Vaccination Report dated within six months of the competition date in accordance with USEF Rule GR845.
- Entry Agreements and Liability Waivers.

## Entry Submission

- NO MAIL-IN, TELEPHONE, DROPPED-OFF, EMAILED, OR FAXED ENTRIES ACCEPTED.
- ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ONLINE.

## Late Entries

- Late entries may be accepted if scheduling permits and must include a \$75 late fee.
- Entries received after the closing date will not be given preference over entries received by the closing date.
- Scratches may be filled at the regular fee by horses that are already entered the competition.

## Entry Confirmation

- If you have not been notified of your status two weeks before the show, please contact the Show Secretary.

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## Refunds

- Before Closing Date: Full refund less Processing Fee.
- After Closing Date: NO REFUNDS.
- "No refunds" includes, but is not limited to, stabling fees and overpayments for any reason, including Acts of God, acts of terrorism, inclement weather, accidents, emergencies, or other unforeseen circumstances.
- All qualified refunds will be processed within thirty (30) days following the conclusion of the competition.

## TIME SCHEDULE

- Official ride times will be posted in the Show Office by noon on Saturday, August 22, 2026.
- Unofficial ride times will be posted online approximately four (4) days prior to the competition.
- Freestyle music sound check will be posted in the Show Office by noon on Saturday, August 22, 2026.

- Schooling schedules will be posted online and in the Show Office.

## GENERAL COMPETITION DIRECTIVES, REGULATIONS, AND POLICIES

*EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.*

- Amateur or Junior/Young Rider competitors must warm up their own horses. Trainers are not permitted to warm up horses entered in the competition.
- If entering more than one horse in the same division, only one horse may be eligible for Division Championship awards and must be declared in the entry.
- Competitors may cross-enter levels but will not be eligible for High Score Division Awards.
- US Equestrian Federation rules are in force from the moment competition management allows access to the showgrounds. This includes conduct, saddlery, equipment, and attire.
- Schooling Show attire is accepted. Formal competition attire is optional.
- Management reserves the right to split, combine, delete, or add classes, dependent upon entries. Management also reserves the right to add or substitute judges or make any changes required by

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- Numbers must be worn at all times whenever a horse is outside of its stall, including while exercising, hand walking, schooling, or competing.
- Hazardous Weather/Accident/Acts of God/Emergency Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any class due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule classes being offered. No refunds will be issued for cancellations due to these circumstances.
- All "No Shows" who have not contacted the Show Office will be considered scratched from the remainder of the competition, and their time slots may be filled.

## **FACILITY POLICIES**

### **Working Out of Trailers**

- Trailers will be parked in the parking lot adjacent to the back gate off of Berley Rd.
- Entering the showgrounds with horses through the Dorset Roadside gate is prohibited.

### **Dog Policy**

- **DOGS MUST BE ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR IN THE STABLE AREAS.**
- **Any owner of a dog found loose on the show grounds will be fined \$100 and will be responsible for the entry fees of any horse whose performance is disrupted as a result.**

### **Smoking Policy**

- NO SMOKING IN OR AROUND THE BARNS.
- Smoking in or around the barns is strictly prohibited. This is a zero-tolerance policy, and violators may be asked to leave the showgrounds.

### **Official Show Photographer**

- Bethany P Photography is the Official Show Photographer.
- Professional photographers not working on assignment for Bethany P Photography are not permitted.
- This restriction applies only to professional photographers and spectators using telephoto or detachable-lens equipment for commercial purposes.
- Spectators may use handheld cameras and cell phones for personal, non-commercial use.
- Personal photographers must remain in spectator areas and may not photograph from arena rails or gate areas.
- For purposes of this policy, a professional photographer is defined as any individual who receives compensation for photography services or image sales.
- Solicitation of photography services on the show grounds or through event-related social media is prohibited.
- Violations of this policy may result in removal from the Devon Horse Show Grounds.

## **SAFETY**

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## **Protective Headgear**

- DR120.6 states that from the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds must wear properly fitted protective headgear meeting or exceeding ASTM/SEI standards and carrying the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

## **VETERINARIAN AND FARRIER**

- Area Veterinarian: On-site. Emergency numbers will be posted in the Show and Stable Offices.
- Farrier: On-site.

## **ARENAS**

- Competitions will take place outdoors in 20M x 60M all-weather sand, geo-felt, and fiber mix arenas.
- Competition classes will be held in the Wheeler or Dixon Oval show rings. There is no guarantee as to which ring classes will be held in.
- Warm-up areas will consist of all-weather sand, geo-felt, and fiber mix footing.

## **Lunging**

- Lunging is permitted in designated areas only during off-show hours.
- All lunging must conclude thirty (30) minutes before scheduled classes begin.
- Lunging and warm-up schedules will be posted and times strictly adhered to.

## **STABLING**

- No horses will be admitted to the grounds before noon on Saturday, August 22, 2026, and must vacate the grounds within two (2) hours after the conclusion of the competition on August 23, 2026.
- Permanent 10' x 10' wooden stalls with doors are available on the show grounds.
- Alteration of stalls or barn structures is strictly prohibited.
- Careful attention is given to horse and tack stall assignments. Do not use stalls that have not been assigned to you.
- Anyone found changing stalls or using a stall without permission from the Stabling Office will be assessed a \$100 fine per stall.
- Placing ANYTHING in a stall constitutes use of that stall.
- Additional stalls may be rented upon arrival, subject to availability. Please contact the Stable Manager.
- Sharps containers are provided in all barn areas.

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## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Food**

- No food service will be available on the competition grounds.
- Numerous restaurants, convenience stores, and food options are located within walking distance or a short drive of the competition grounds.

### **Parking**

- Trailers and vans will not be permitted to park inside the show grounds except for brief loading and unloading.
- Parking and security will be provided in designated parking lots surrounding the show grounds.
- Trailers and vans must be parked in designated lots outside the show grounds.
- Competitors should bring wheelbarrows, carts, or hand trucks for unloading from parking areas.
- If arriving after dark, please be aware that lighting is limited in the back barn unloading area.

### **Directions**

- From Interstate 95, take Route 476 to the Villanova/St. David Exit (13), then proceed west on Route 30. The Devon Horse Show Grounds are approximately six (6) miles on the left.

- This is presented at each Level. Amateurs and Jr/Yr awarded separately.
- Intro – Second and WD: Is calculated by the average of two tests ridden at the same level. One of the two tests ridden must be the second test of the level, i.e: Tr. 2, First2 etc.
- Third -FEI: Only one test of the level is required.

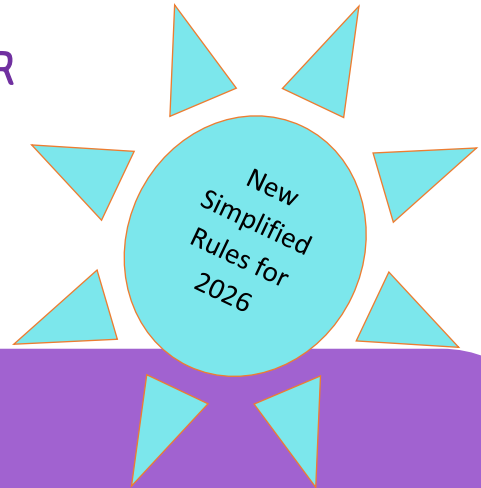
### **Specialty Awards:**

## Rules:

- Team entry fee is \$40 per Team, in addition to class entry fees. Teams can be all Amateur's, all Jr/YR's or a mixed team.
- Teams can consist of 3-4 riders at any level, with their highest score of the day counted.
- No more than 2 riders at each level.
- Each horse may only show on one team, but a rider can show on up to 2 teams.
- If the team consists of 4 riders, the lowest score will be a drop score.
- Highest team score wins. In case of ties, the highest single score on a team will decide.
- No substitution of horse or rider on a team after the first ride of the team test has started.
- ✓ Ribbons and prizes to Champion and Reserve Champion Teams. Ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place.

**B. Activity Risk Classification**

RIDER UNDERSTANDS THAT: Horseback riding is a hazardous activity containing numerous inherent, obvious and non-obvious risks that always present themselves in such activity, despite all safety precautions. Related injuries can be severe, resulting in more lasting residual effects than injuries from other activities. Horses are unpredictable and participation in activities in the presence of horses always involves an element of risk. Pursuant to Act 93 of 2005, the Pennsylvania Activity Immunity Act, "You assume the risk of equine activities pursuant to Pennsylvania Law."

**C. Nature of Riding Horses**

RIDER UNDERSTANDS THAT: No horse is a completely safe horse. Regardless of a horse's training or past experience, a horse may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, bolt, stumble, rear, kick, run, stop short, fall, bite, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's foot/feet, push or shove a person, saddles, girths or bridles may loosen or break, all of which may cause Rider to fall or be jolted, resulting in property damage, personal injury, or death. DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC is not responsible for total or partial acts, occurrences, or elements of nature that can scare a horse or cause it to fall or react in any unsafe way.

**D. Rider Responsibility**

RIDER UNDERSTANDS THAT: Rider is in primary control of the horse, and DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC is not responsible for Rider's actions or inactions. Rider is responsible for their own safety and that of an unborn child if Rider is pregnant. Pregnant persons should ride horses only under the advice of their physician.

**E. Protective Equipment/Headgear Requirement**

As a condition of riding any horse in the Amateur Only Dressage Show, Rider is required by DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC to wear and utilized all protective clothing and equipment, including long pants, gloves, protective headgear and proper riding shoes with heels, at all times while mounting, riding, and dismounting horses. Rider's headgear must meet or exceed ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carry the SEI tag. The headgear and its harness must be secured, properly fitted and fastened at all times while mounting, riding, and dismounting horses. If Rider is in violation of this requirement at any time, Rider must immediately discontinue riding until such headgear is properly in place. Closed toe shoes that cover the whole foot are required by all persons on the horse facilities, at all times when working with or around horses. Rider is responsible for ensuring all their spectators and guests abide by this rule if they come within 6 feet of a horse.

#### **F. Property**

RIDER AGREES THAT: DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC is not responsible for lost or stolen personal property of any kind, including saddles, and any other item of value. Rider acknowledges it is their responsibility to secure and insure their personal property.

#### **G. Dunmovin's Use of My Name and Image**

I understand that DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC may take photos or videos of Rider. Rider consents to the use by DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC of Rider's image, voice, name, and stories (collectively, "Materials"), in DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC digital and print promotional, fundraising, educational, and other communications. DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC may use the Materials without obtaining Rider's approval or paying Rider for such use. I grant DUNMOVIN DRESSAGE DAYS LLC all copyrights in and waive any legal claims relating to the Materials, including those relating to copyright, rights of publicity or privacy, or defamation, or arising from any distortion, blurring, or alteration that may occur in the making, editing, or use of the Materials.

In the event that any provision of this Release and Waiver of Liability shall be unenforceable or invalid under any applicable law or be so held by applicable court state decision, such unenforceability or invalidity shall not render this whole Release and Waiver of Liability unenforceable or invalid as a whole.
